Summary of meeting

1. Presentation –Health & Wellbeing Project in North Leek ward

Tiffany Mc Gurk from the project, which is funded by Staffs CC, outlined the programmes that are being offered free every Thursday to residents of Leek North ward at Haregate Community Centre until June 2020.

3. Report on CCG Survey and Results from Locality PPG meeting

The group are also trying to get meaningful engagement with the Midland Partnership NHS Trust which covers Staffordshire and Shropshire Care in the community and community hospitals.
